Walking to the school gate and walking home

Please note that only children in Years Four, Five and Six are allowed to walk to the school gate. If you would like your child to walk to the gate, please could you complete the required form which is available from the school office.

Only children in Year Six are permitted to walk home alone. This also requires parental consent on the relevant form, also available from the office. No child will be allowed to walk to the gate or walk home without the correct paperwork.

School Uniform

We are very proud of our school identity which is clearly reflected in our school uniform. To maintain these high standards, could we request that children's hair accessories are in keeping with our school uniform; for example small green or red bows or hair bands.

Trousers

As part of our school uniform, we will be introducing long trousers during our coldest months. Therefore, after the October half term until February half term, there will be the option to be able to wear long grey trousers.

PE Kit Expectations

Please be aware that PE kit should be in school every day. This includes the school tracksuit during the colder months, a spare pair of socks and trainers or plimsolls.

Could we remind all children that while we welcome bicycles and scooters being ridden to and from the school, they are not permitted to ride them on the school grounds.
