- Girls... tie that hair back please!


# Homework Time!

- Organising school bag



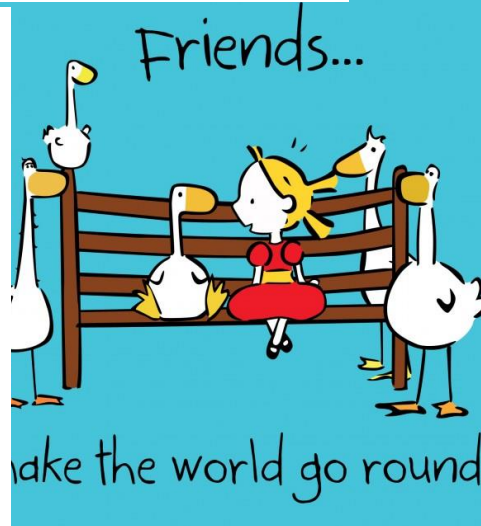
