



New date for Visit from Birds of Prey Expert Alan Ames is Monday 26th March

On Monday 26th March the children will be having a talk on the ecology and conservation of Birds of Prey by Mr. Alan Ames from Eagle Heights in Eynsford, Kent. They will be shown different birds, with a focus on owls to tie in with our Harry Potter theme.

This is the event that was postponed from Friday 2nd March.

After the talk there will be an opportunity for the children to have their photograph taken, holding one of the birds on their gloved hand. Each colour photograph will cost £5.00 with a mount and will measure 5" by 7".
