Swimming for the Summer Term 2018 - Years 3 and 4

'An important Life skill'

We are very pleased to inform you Year 3 and Year 4 pupils will once again be attending swimming lessons at Darrick Wood Pool. Swimming is part of the national curriculum and is a vital skill for life, supporting the development of a healthy lifestyle. Year 3 children will attend on a Tuesday (10.30am-11am) and Year 4 children on a Friday (11am-11.30am) for 8 weeks during the Summer Term only. The children will walk to and from the pool escorted by members of staff. Children are supervised at the pool by Farnborough staff and are taught by swimming teachers provided by Darrick Wood Pool. The groupings are at the discretion of the Darrick Wood swimming teachers according to your child's ability. Please let us know how confident your child is using the form overleaf. Children will return to school in time for lunch. We have again chosen to provide swimming lessons during the Summer Term **only** as hopefully the weather will be warmer. Clothing

Girls should wear a one piece black or navy blue swimsuit and swimming hat. Hair must be tied back with no accessories. *Bikinis are not permitted.*

Boys should wear black or navy blue swimming trunks and a swimming hat. *Swimming shorts are not permitted.*

- Children are allowed to wear goggles if they wish. All items need to be named especially swimming towels.
- Children may wear their school track suits over their school uniform to provide extra layers.
