Visit to the London Aquarium

On Friday 24 May 2019, Year 3 will be visiting the London Aquarium, travelling to London by train from Orpington Station. We will advise you of the activities and exact timings for the day after the Easter Break.

The children must wear smart school uniform for the trip, weather permitting, have a sun hat and waterproof coat with them, together with their school rucksack. Please could provide your child with a healthy packed lunch for the trip, which includes a sandwich, piece of fruit, water or juice and a biscuit. It should not include fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate.

There is a charge of £13.00 towards the cost of the entrance and workshops at the Aquarium, which can either be paid via AGORA, our online payment system or by cash/cheque to the school office. Voluntary contributions may be requested but no pupil may be disqualified from taking part by parents' unwillingness to pay. If more than a few parents are unwilling to pay voluntarily then the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.

If you are unable to drop and collect your child from Orpington Station, please indicate on the form and we will arrange an alternative.

We will return to Orpington Station by 3pm, should the arrival back at school be delayed a text message will be sent to all parents.

We would like to take parent/carer helpers with us on this trip. If you would be able to help, please indicate on the form.
