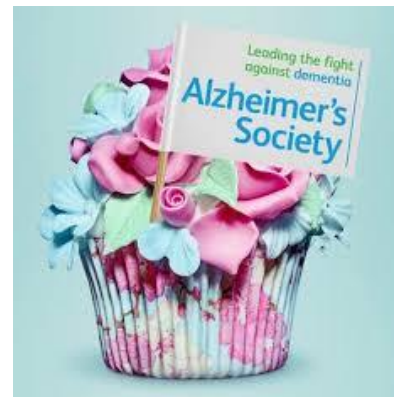


CUPCAKE SALE!
