

# Jolly Jam Jars

Dear Parents,

On **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November** we are asking for "Jolly Jam Jar" donations. Children can wear an item of red with their uniform on this day.

Jolly Jam Jars are a jam jar (or any jar with a lid) that has been festively decorated and filled with goodies. The contents could be sweets, stationary, hairbands toiletries, stickers, etc.

## Instructions

- Find a jar with a lid wash and dry it thoroughly. Leaving it to soak in hot water or running it through the dishwasher usually removes all traces of labels.
- Your child can decorate their jar however you and they choose. You can use stickers, sharpies, glass paints, sequins or anything else you chose. Allow the jar to dry thoroughly before filling it.
- Fill your jar with goodies of your choice.
- Make sure your child's name and class is on the bottom of your jar

**There is a prize for the best jar in each class!**

There is no limit to the number of jars that can be entered. All jolly jam jars are entered in to a very popular tombola at the Christmas Market.
