Visit to the V & A's Museum of Childhood - Wednesday 18th March 2020 - Elves Class, Year One

As part of our work in History we are planning to take the children in Year One to the V & A's Museum of Childhood at Bethnal Green, London on Wednesday 18th March 2020. The trip includes a workshop where the children will have the opportunity to make a toy and learn about about toys from the past. The award-winning Museum offers exhibits and activities linked with the History curriculum and will extend the work we have done in class.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9am and we shall be leaving the Museum at 2.00 pm thus ensuring that the children will be back by 3.00pm to be collected from school as normal. The children should wear school uniform and are not required to bring in a school bag on that day. A packed lunch will be provided for all the children, via our catering contractor, Nourish, consisting of either a ham, tuna, cheese or jam bap, a piece of fruit, a drink and a cookie. Any specific dietary requirements are to be noted on the slip below.

There is a charge of £16.50 towards the cost of the coach and activities which can either be paid via SIMS Pay, our online payment system, or by cash/cheque handed into the School Office in a sealed envelope marked with your child's name, class and 'Museum of Childhood. Voluntary contributions may be requested but no pupil may be disqualified from taking part by parents' unwillingness to pay. If more than a very few parents are unwilling to pay voluntarily then the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals (not Universal Infant Free School Meals) this trip will be paid for by the school.

Please complete the permission slip below, indicating your child's packed lunch preference, and enclosing the £16.50 contribution, if appropriate, or indicating payment made on SIMS Pay and return it to me as soon as possible.

Parental helpers are required for the visit. Please indicate on the slip below if you are available and I will let you know if you are required.
