# It's party time!





My friends are Rosie, Sarah, George and Sam.







# It's party time!

Elves, now it's time to make a party crown!

**You will need...**

- 1 Some card for a headband  
so long enough to go around your head.
- 2 Double sided sticky tape.

**To make it...**

- 1 Cut the card into strips 4cm thick.  
Get an adult to help measure your  
head, cutting the strip of card to size.
- 2 Take your double sided sticky  
tape and stick it along the  
length of the headband.
- 3 Do not remove the outer part  
of the tape until you are ready  
to stick things on!
- 4 Take your headband to the forest  
and search for different leaves,  
grass heads or other light weight  
natural materials to stick to it.
- 5 Once you are happy with your design,  
overlap the two ends slightly to form  
a circle and stick together with tape.
- 6 Don't forget to take your  
Gruffalo badge with you to  
stick on the front of your crown,  
for the finishing touch!

# Shape Animals

Now you can be

A Gruffalo mask  
to colour and make




**Directions:**

1. Trace this about on A3 paper size
2. Colour it!
3. Stick on some wool
4. Cut out mask along dashed lines  
but an adult to help with the cutting out!
5. Cut around eye and mouth holes
6. Tape a pencil to the back of the mask  
and under the mouth. Now hold the mask  
to your face and go 'Gruffalo!'!

## MOUSE MASK

You will need crayons or felt tips, scissors, sticky tape, and a stick!

1. Carefully cut around the mask, following the dotted lines (ask an adult to help with cutting out)
2. Carefully cut two eye holes
3. Decorate your mask by colouring it in
4. Attach to a stick using sticky tape





Every day I am going to give you an activity that can be carried out either outdoors, (if the sun is shining) or indoors (if we're not as lucky as the weather!).



Now's the time to create your Gruffalo party! The invites , crowns and masks are complete. Can you create some colourful party decorations and organise a Gruffalo party!




## How to make your bunting

- 3 Pierce holes with pencil.
- 4 Cut out the shapes.
- 5 Weave the string through holes.


