3. Would you like to be a Day or Night Zookeeper? Explain you reasons why.







Which of these images below show the number 32?




Joins

The score shown is $8 + 15 + 6 + 18 = 47$.




Find the highest possible score.



Time passed, and King Prasutagus passed away.




BUT! He left a will...


WILL
