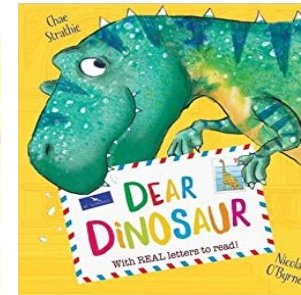
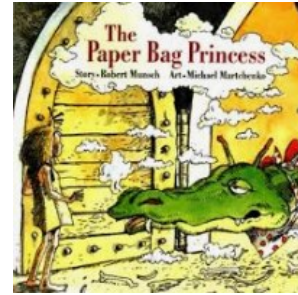

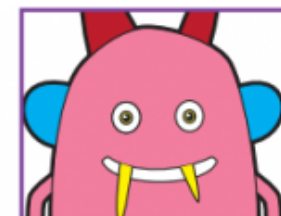

Phonics Screening



English

As **readers and writers** we will continue to focus on spelling, handwriting and writing sentences this term. We will look at a variety of types of writing: non fiction recounts, information texts, letter writing, fiction and pattern and rhyme in poetry.



Mathematics

As **mathematicians** we will continue exploring numbers, including counting and sequencing. We will be developing mental strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be looking at fractions of shape and number.



Topic

As **geographers and historians** our first topic will be learning about **Castles and Conquerors** we will be looking at the location and types of castles in the United Kingdom



Topic

As **geographers and historians** our second topic will be learning about **Dinosaurs Discovery!** We will cover the Triassic, Jurassic and Cretaceous periods. We will also look at different types of dinosaurs and where they have been found.



PE

As **athletes** will continue to learn ball skills and games. We will also begin to practise for our Infants Sports Day.

This term P.E. days may vary as we are lucky enough to have outside companies teaching us cricket and tennis.

Each class will have PE twice a week. Please ensure that PE kits are in school at all times and that all items are clearly labelled.

Science

As **scientists** our first topic this term is **seasonal change**. We will observe weather associated with the seasons and how the length of the day varies.

Our second topic this term is **lifecycles**, we will observe a variety of invertebrates and their structure as well as the life cycle of a butterfly.



Art/DT

As **artists and designers** we will be observing pictures of castles closely and using pencils and charcoal to carefully draw them. We will also create our castles in the style of the artist Paul Klee.



RE

As **good citizens** we will continue learning about Judaism and begin to learn about Hinduism.



Music

As **musicians** we will be learning how to identify a beat within a piece of music. We will also work on composing our own pieces of music.



PSHE

In **PSHE** we will be looking at **relationships**. We will discuss different ways others can be teased or bullied how we can be good friends.



Computing

In **computing** we will continue to explore the world of **coding** and learning new terminology such as 'algorithms'.
