They will be developing links with a local Architects office and exploring the architecture in the locality and a contrasting area. In addition we will then be developing this further in the realm of Minecraft.







Here are the books we will be working on in our English lessons in the Summer term:







English

Through English we will begin to explore suspense and tension with writing based on Wolf Brother. This book is an adventure story set thousands of year ago. There is plenty of page turning drama which the children will thoroughly immerse themselves in. Next they will be working on Wonder a book about a boy with a facial disfigurement, which at first alienates him from his new class mates but over time he is able to win them over with his engaging personality.

Mathematics

In Mathematics children will be working on geometry. Children will be learning how to recognise and work out the size of angles, using the information given. They will also be looking at properties of shapes, direction and position.



Science

In Science children will work scientifically by: exploring falling paper cones or cup-cake cases, and designing and making a variety of parachutes and carrying out fair tests to determine which designs are the most effective. They will explore resistance in water by making and testing boats of different shapes. They will design and make products that use levers, pulleys, gears and/or springs and explore their effects.



In Computing this term, children will create loops, debug code, build structures, and create their own animations with Minecraft.

Computing

In addition, we will be exploring Sketch Up an architectural programme for children.



RE

In RE we will focus on the Journey of life and exploring changes. Children will think about the circumstances that change things in people's lives? They will discuss the different rites of passage that pupils can think of or have experienced so far in their lives.

Children will understand what is meant by construction. They will explore the history of the local area and the buildings that are there. Looking at the local area they will determine the needs of their local community and decide on the purpose of a new building. We will be building links with a local architectural office in the village and explore the role of an architect in designing a new building. Next we will explore the role of an engineer and decide the building design based on accessibility and sustainability. The children will then create a model of the new building using designs and reflect on, evaluate and adapt their designs if necessary. Finally they will share their work at a design fair.

Topic



The children will be taking part in netball, cricket and athletic sessions during our lessons this term. We have two weekly PE lessons, which we will be able to develop their many sporting skills. Could you please ensure their PE kit is in school at all times and that all items are clearly labelled.



As Musicians, they will be continuing to develop their Recorder skills with an emphasis on varying and combining rhythms to create new sounds.
