KIT LIST:

- Luggage please use a small suitcase or holdall preferably with wheels as the children will need to carry/wheel this
- Lots of old, warm clothes clothes can get a bit dirty so don't bring anything too precious (Jumpers will be needed)
- Wash kit including 2 towels, soap/ body wash, flannel/sponge, toothbrush and toothpaste hairbrush/comb, roll – on deodorant, shampoo, conditioner if required (which should be labelled)
- At least two pairs of old trainers (including a pair for raft building which will get wet and very muddy) - no sandals
- Wellies Sayers Croft can lend wellies if necessary
- Waterproofs jacket and bottoms if available (optional)
- Personal medication including sunscreen and after sun if required
- Indoor footwear slippers/flip flops
- Warm night clothes night wear/dressing gown (optional)
- Changes of underwear please allow enough for wet activities and weather!
- Hat (appropriate for the weather) and gloves
- Small teddy bear / soft toy if needed
- **Camera -** this should be disposable and clearly named. Please could you make sure your child knows how to use a disposable camera.
- Drinks Bottle please ensure this is named
- Reading book/magazines
- Hair bands if you have long hair
- 3 Black bags to put dirty and wet clothes in
- 2 plastic bags to put items such as wet shoes in
