Dear Parents/Carers,

We apologise for the amount of letters we are sending out at the moment but we would like to keep you informed to the best of our ability during the coronavirus outbreak as events and guidance are changing daily and this in turn is affecting the day to day running of the school.

The current guidance from the Government states that if anyone in your household is displaying any of the symptoms of the coronavirus – a cough or a high temperature or shortness of breath – they should self-isolate for 14 days. If your child is off school due to these circumstances, the absences will be marked as authorised.

We continue to remind the children to wash their hands thoroughly at regular times during the day and we continue to take the precautions listed in yesterday's correspondence.

School work for children in isolation at home
