

Dear Staff, Parents and Carers,

19 March 2020 - Statement update from Nexus Education Schools Trust (NEST)

The Government has announced that schools will **close at the end of Friday until further notice, for the majority of pupils.**

As advised by the government, and in the first instance, we will be keeping all of our schools open for the children of **Key Workers** and **vulnerable pupils who have Education Health Care Plans and those with an assigned Social Worker.** The initial Government statement identified Key Workers as:-

- NHS Staff
- Ambulance Service
- Police Service
- Fire Service
- Armed Forces
- Care Workers for the elderly
- Delivery Drivers

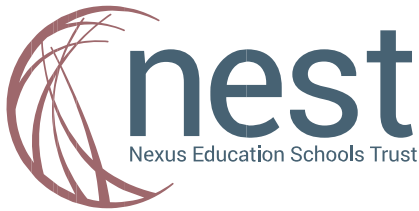
The exact Key Worker criteria has yet to be announced by Government, however, we have added the children of delivery drivers to our survey in line with the Government announcement made last night. We are aware that many of our parents work for the NHS and front line services and will need child care to allow them to continue their vital work.

All of the children, whether at home or at school, will be asked to complete their home learning activities. Currently, we cannot guarantee the number of staff who will be able to work to provide care and supervision on site. We are working hard to assess the needs of parents and the number of children for whom we need to provide key worker and vulnerable pupil support. **Initially, on Monday, we will open all our schools. Going forward, we will nominate hub schools across the Trust for this provision, based on pupils and staff numbers.** Our provision across NEST will be reviewed continuously.

It is imperative that parents let us know via the Survey Monkey and /or the hard copy attached to this letter, whether they need to make use of this potential offer to Key Workers and families of with vulnerable children.

We will continue to provide home learning for those children not in school. Your child's school would have sent a separate letter with home learning information and you will continue to receive information when this is updated.

The Government has advised that no exams or tests will be held this academic year.
