

'WHAT YOU LOOK FORWARD TO DOING ONCE LOCK-DOWN IS LIFTED'

ART COMPETITION ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. Each entry must be designed by the child
2. The theme of the competition is to design 'What you look forward to doing once lock-down is lifted'.
3. All entries should be prepared in landscape format on an A4 sheet of paper.
4. The competition is open to infant and primary pupils.
5. Entries that progress to the final stages of the competition may require the signature of the child's parent or legal guardian.
6. Entries must be submitted by email to chelsfield@langford-rae.co.uk, confirming the child's age, year group and school.
7. Only one entry per child is permitted.
8. Entries must be submitted via email by 5pm on Sunday 24th May 2020. Entries received after this date and time will not be accepted.
9. Judges will take the following into consideration when judging the entries:
 - a. It is a creative design using different drawing techniques e.g. shading, textures,
 - b. An overriding presence of imagination and style.
 - c. Good use of art materials.
 - d. Where the entry is well presented and neat.
10. The Promoters will each collect and process personal information of the children who enter the competition, including their names, ages and the schools they attend. This personal information will be used by the Promoters to administer and run the competition and in the ways described in these terms and conditions.
11. In relation to entries submitted, the school is responsible for and must obtain all necessary parental/guardian consents and must provide all necessary notices required in connection with the disclosure and use of personal information (including that of the entrants) as described in these terms and conditions.

12. Entries may be used to publicise the competition across various media platforms (including on Langford Rae websites and Langford Rae media displays). These publicised entries may use the child's first name, school name and location.
13. The School will be informed of the Winner, and notified by Langford Rae no later than 26th May 2020.
