




What is vocabulary and where might we find it?




Vocabulary is a list or collection of words and their meanings.

words mean?






We are going to share a story about a little girl who should have used her dictionary to look up the tricky word **miscellaneous**.

Do you know what this word means?


Miscellaneous

hot




cold


