Farnborough's Race around the World

Congratulations for taking part in the Active Challenge last week, we are so impressed with the incredible distances covered across seven days. Take a look at the class results, these are found on our webpage <http://farnboroughprimary.co.uk/active-challenge/> Pegasus class are our current champions having covered a staggering 1,821 kilometres.

As the Active Challenge has been a tremendous success we would like to launch Farnborough's Race around the World starting from today Tuesday 26th May and ending Monday 13th July. Are you ready to complete Farnborough's Race around the World? The weeks will run from Tuesday to Monday, the first week starting Tuesday 26th May and ending Monday 1st June, the second week will commence Tuesday 2nd June and end Monday 8th June and so on.

Each family needs to count how many kilometres they cover each day; all activities are worthy, it can be walking a dog, short and long walks, riding on a bike or scooter, short and long runs, working out on a treadmill and so on. To measure your distances, there are a number of fitness apps available on android or iphone for example, mapmyrun by underarma, strava, runkeeper or alternatively, use google maps or retrieve information from a fitbit.

Once a week is completed, send in the total number of kilometres to your class teacher and we will add your total to the class' total. The cut off day to send in your week's total is each Tuesday by 6pm. If there is more than one child in a family, send in the same family total to each class.

The results of our race will be posted on the Active Challenge learning page. A recording sheet is attached for your child to record the number of kilometres covered each day and each week.

So let's see which class will win the race around the world. Good luck!
