(Do you remember the rhymes that we made up in class to help us remember compass points?)



Hansel and Gretel- Through the woods


Hansel and Gretel have escaped the evil witch and are setting off for a new life with their Aunt Candy on the other side of the forest,





Every day I am going to give you an activity that can be carried out either outdoors, (if the sun is shining) or indoors (if we're not as lucky as the weather!).




