Birthday in a Treehouse

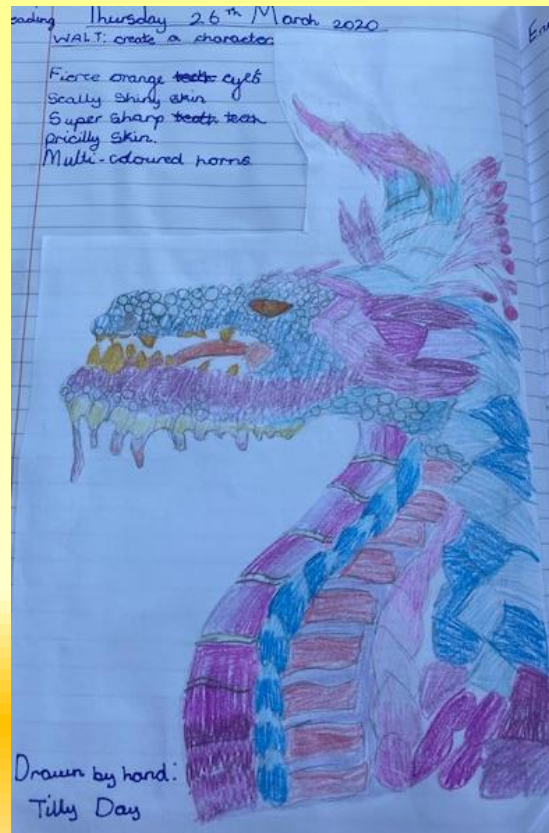
