Although we are still living within many restrictions and constraints at school and in our daily lives, we really want to make sure that the children have a wonderful Christmas at school.

Whilst we will obviously have to do this within the limitations of our risk assessments, and all events will have to be very carefully thought through, we have tried to ensure we still have a range of fun activities for the children to take part in.

Unfortunately, we will be unable to hold any productions for years one - year six. This is due to only one year group being able to practise in the hall due to the amount of cleaning we have to do after each class or group has used a shared space. Therefore, instead of our usual productions and services, each class will be holding a small Christmas Market to celebrate 'The Twelve Days of Christmas'. Children will make items to do with Christmas or their topic and parents/carers will be invited to their child's class market at 2:15pm on a specific day where they will be able to buy items that their children have made. All money raised from the markets will be donated to charity; of which there are so many to choose from this year.

Due to the fact that a Reception Nativity is a once in a lifetime memory for parents/carers, we will be holding a Reception Nativity, this however will only be able to be viewed via Zoom. We did consider doing an outdoor performance, but the logistics and hoping for good weather was too much of a risk. Unlike, other years though, this does mean that as many tickets as you want will be available.

We know at this time of year class reps start to organise collections for the school staff by way of saying 'thank you' to the teams that work with your children. Whilst these are very appreciated by the staff, we have unanimously agreed that we have been exceptionally fortunate as a profession this year and we have had the added bonus of being able to come to work with your children, even during this second Lockdown. We recognise that many of you have not been as lucky as us, and have either had to work from home, or had your lives turned upside down by a change in your personal circumstances, therefore, our suggestion is that any money collected for staff is donated to charity instead.
