Trips

Children everywhere have lost out of so many fun experiences over the past eighteen months, so due to the fact that all of our school trips were booked to outdoor venues that have been open since April, all of our school trips are still going ahead. We feel confident that because the children are travelling to their venues in their 'bubbles' and are attending outdoor places these visits can go ahead. For most of our visits, we have been able to use the school staff to ensure we are above adult to child ratio. Any year groups where we need additional adults will be notified individually.

The safety of all of our children is paramount, so we have of course put in lots of additional measures in place to ensure that the children have an incredible day out with their friends.
