Year 4 Visit to The National Maritime Museum - 28th March 2022

We are very pleased to let you know that a trip to The National Maritime Museum has been arranged to support the children's learning as part of our 'Raiders or Settlers' topic. The children are going to have the opportunity to go around the museum seeing a variety of different exhibitions within the museum as well as taking part in a Vikings Workshop in the afternoon where the children will have the opportunity to dig up the past to examine Viking graves, vessels and artefacts, and step into the shoes of a Viking to discover how their seafaring talents took them far and wide across the globe. The children will investigate what made the Vikings unique as raiders, invaders and traders. They will have the opportunity to handle replica artefacts and clothing to step into the shoes of a Viking. Helping the children to develop their enquiry, reasoning and communication skills. This will be a great opportunity for the topic to be brought to life for the children through a fun day and a talk with experts.

We shall be travelling by train from Orpington Station. We will be catching the 09:41 train from Orpington to Cutty Sark. If you are unable to drop and collect your child from Orpington Station, please indicate on the form and we will arrange an alternative. We will return to Orpington Station by 15:10, should the arrival back at school be delayed a text message will be sent to all parents.

The children can wear their own clothes for this visit, which should be suitable for outdoor activities and they should have a waterproof coat to wear on the day.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or half a baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. This will be payable in the usual way via PAY 360 at the cost of £2.30.

There is a charge of £2.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via PAY 360, our online payment system. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.
