Visit to Churchill Theatre for Pixies, Unicorns, Giants and Dragons Class

Jack & the Beanstalk Panto! Thursday 8 December 2022

We are so excited to confirm we have managed to secure a group booking for the children to watch Jack and the Beanstalk Pantomime at Churchill Theatre in Bromley. Oh no we didn't..... oh yes, we did!

Your child's class is invited to attend on Thursday 8 December. We have booked a coach to transport the children and adults to the Churchill Theatre and will depart the school at approximately 12pm after an early lunch sitting. The panto starts at 1.30pm and we are asking for all children to be collected by parents/carers at 3.45pm from an allocated pick-up point near the Theatre. (this will be confirmed at a later date)

We have also secured a limited number of additional tickets for parent helpers which will be allocated to classes based on the ratios needed and then selected at random from those who indicate they would like to attend. Please note if you are selected to help you will be required to purchase an adult ticket and you will need to travel with the group by coach and be collected from Bromley once the children have been handed over to parents.

We have secured a discounted rate for the tickets, so the cost for a child ticket including travel to the venue is £19.50 and the price of an adult ticket if you are selected to attend is £25.00 including travel to the venue. Tickets for children can be paid on Pay 360 and adult tickets will also be made available to pay once you have been confirmed as a helper. We are very aware that the cost of living has increased significantly and continues to do so. If you are unable to pay the full amount in one instalment, we are happy for payment to be made in four instalments. If you are struggling to pay for a ticket for your child, please do hesitate to speak to Miss James.

All children will be required to bring a drink and a savoury snack which they can have at the theatre. Please may we ask that you do not pack sweets, chocolate, or fizz!

At a later date, if we have any remaining tickets to offer, we will notify parents of a release date and time on Pay 360 and these will be allocated on a first come first serve basis, however you will be expected to travel on the coach and assist as additional help.
