

Dear Parent/Carer

The National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) will soon be underway at your child's school, for children in Reception and Year 6. Vision Screening will also be taking place for children in Reception.

Some Reception children did not receive their vision screening in school last year. If your child did not receive their vision screening and is under 6 years of age at the time we are visiting their school, they will also be offered vision screening. You will need to follow the instructions towards the end of this letter, regarding registering on parent portal, to receive further information, results, or to opt your child out of screening.

If your child did not receive their vision screening in school last year and is aged 6 or over at the time we visit their school, they will not be able to be screened. You are advised to take your child for a vision screening at your local optician. This will be free of charge and your child will receive the correct screening for their age.

If you haven't already done so, please remember to register for a School Health Parent Portal account so you can read more about the programme and access your child's results following their screening.

**What do I need to do?**

- Step 1. Click the link below, this will take you to the registration landing page
- Step 2. Log in and fill in your child's information
- Step 3. Read the information provided and SUBMIT the form
- Step 4. Once you are linked with your child's results you will be able to opt out of the NCMP and/or vision screening if you wish and read more information about the screening programme.
