KS2 Choir Performance at Bromley Schools' Prom

We are very excited to inform you that the Farnborough KS2 Choir are taking part in the Bromley Schools' Proms, which is an event organised by BYMT (Bromley Youth Music Trust).

After many years of not being able to hold this event due to covid, it is great to be part of this celebration of music with many schools coming together again.

The KS2 choir from Farnborough will be performing two songs by themselves, conducted by Miss Seeney who leads them. They will also take part in the massed choir performance which is sung by children from lots of Bromley Primary Schools. There will be a range of musical pieces played and sung throughout the evening from a variety of primary and secondary schools in Bromley with the finale being performed by the BYMT youth band.

The concert will be held on Tuesday 14 March at the Fairfield Halls in Croydon starting at 7pm; however, the children will be required to arrive at 6.30pm. It is due to finish at around 10pm.

Tickets will be available to purchase from Monday 13 February 2023 and are only available from The Fairfield Box Office, www.fairfield.co.uk priced at £10 (£6.50 child).
