As promised, I am writing to provide you with a buildings update. If any of you have walked past the school over the past week, I am sure you will have noticed that the works have definitely started.

The main difference that you and the children will notice on Monday is that there is now fencing across the old KS1 and KS2 entrance to the building.



Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two will continue to use the path that runs alongside the side of the building and through to the key stage one playground to come into and leave school. Children in years three to six, will continue to use the main entrance.

Our evacuation point will now be on the field, leaving the school site if necessary, via the KS1 playground. We will do a practise on Monday morning, so please explain to your children that this will be happening if you feel this will cause them any distress.
