Dear Parents/Carers,

Pegasus (Year 3) Visit to The London Aquarium on Wednesday 24 May 2023

We are planning to take Pegasus Class to the London Aquarium on Wednesday 24 May 2023 as part of our Geography topic, Blue Planet.

We shall be travelling by train, departing Orpington at 9.38 a.m. Please could your child be dropped off at 9.15 a.m. at the main entrance to Orpington station (taxi rank side) to be registered before departure. We aim to be back at Orpington station for 3 p.m. If you are unable to arrange dropping your child to the station at this time, please ensure your child is in school by 8.30 a.m. on this day to enable us enough time to walk to the station. If you are unable to arrange collection of your child at 3 p.m. we shall walk back to school.

The children will be required to wear their full school uniform and shoes which will be suitable for walking around the aquarium.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch. A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or half a baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. This will be payable in the usual way via Pay 360 at the cost of £2.47.

There is a charge of £10.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via Pay 360, our online payment system. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.
