	decade	A decade is a length which is ten years long; it begins and ends with a year ending in 0 (2010 to 2010 is a decade).	
	timeline	Timeline means an order of time to show events, devices (objects) or people's lives along a timeline.	
	chronology chronological	Chronology shows how events, people and things are ordered over time from oldest to newest.	
	transport	Transport means moving people or goods from one place to another.	
	travel	Travel means moving from one place to another.	
	invention	Invention means a creation of a device (type of object) for the very first time. It has not existed before.	
	Viking longboat	Longboats were used by Vikings to travel to other countries.
