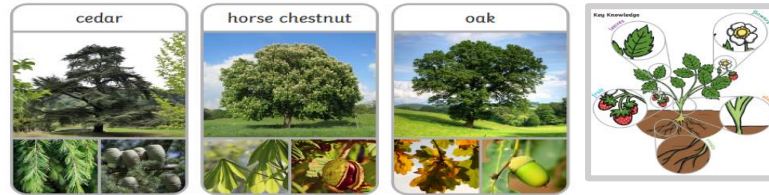
Key Vocabulary

| Wild Plant | A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows. |
| Garden plant | Garden plants are plants that people choose to grow in their gardens. |
| Deciduous | A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year. |
| Evergreen | An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter. |
| Weed | Weeds are wild plants that grow in places where people don't want them. |
| Root | A root takes in water and nutrients from the soil and keeps the plant in the ground. |
| Stem | The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers |
| Leaf | A leaf catches sunlight to help the plant make its own food. |
| Flower | A flower attracts insects and birds. |
| Petal | Petals are the colourful part of the flower. |
| Fruit | Fruit contains the plant's seeds. Fruits are eaten by animals, including humans. |
| Bulb | A bulb is an underground stem or seed of a seed plant. |
| Nut | A nut is a fruit with a hard or tough nutshell. |
| Seed | A seed is a small object for a plant to grow. |
