Music

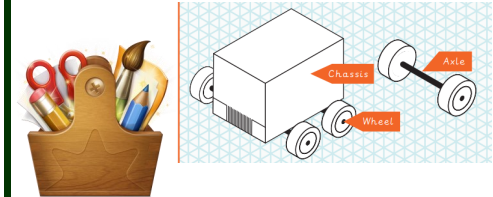
As **Musicians** we will be exploring untuned percussion instruments.

As **Readers** we will continue to learn and apply our phonics in our reading, develop our fluency and expression skills. We will discuss and analyse texts to develop our comprehension skills.

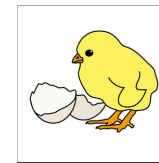
As **Writers** we will learn to write a set of instructions and then move on to write an explanation text.
