	<p>Tourist Attraction</p>	<p>A place of interest where tourists visit. Tourist is a person who travels for pleasure.</p>		
	<p>Skyline</p>	<p>The line or shape that is formed where the sky meets buildings or the land.</p>		
	<p>Rural</p>	<p>A place with few homes or other buildings, and not very many people.</p>	<p>•</p>	
	<p>Urban</p>	<p>A place where many people live and work, which can be very crowded They are mostly taken up by roads, pavements, buildings, and maybe small grassy areas.</p>	<p>•</p>
