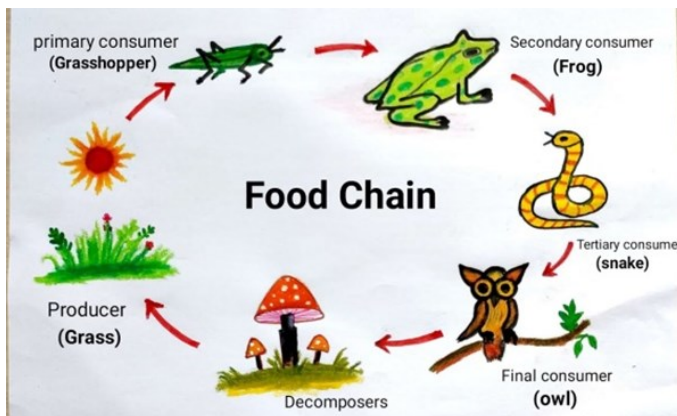
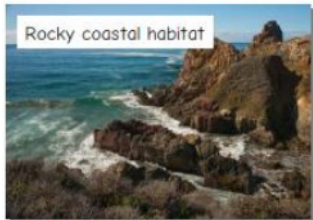




Could these creatures live in any habitat?

Food chain	Food chains show what animals eat.		
Living things	All living things can do these 7 things: Move Reproduce - have offspring Sense - can tell if things change Grow - get bigger Respiration - make energy from glucose and oxygen Excrete - get rid of waste products need Nutrients - substances needed for survival		
Organisms	Any living thing. Plants and animals are organisms		
Microhabitat	A microhabitat is a very specific, small home environment for plants, animals and insects. Examples include: ponds; individual trees; under a stone; a pile of logs.
