Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 3 Visit to British Museum – Thursday 9 November 2023

On Thursday 9 November, Year 3 will be visiting the British Museum, London as part of their topic on the Ancient Egyptians. The children will visit the relevant galleries and will have the opportunity to see Ancient Egyptian artefacts in a curator led session, 'Excavation in Egypt' workshop.

We will be travelling to London by coach, leaving school **promptly at 8.20 a.m.** so children must arrive at school no later than 8.10 am for registration in the classroom. Unfortunately, any child who arrives after 8.20 am will not be able to accompany the class on the trip as the coach will have departed. We will return to school by 3.15 pm. Should the arrival back at school be delayed an email will be sent to all parents. The children must wear correct school uniform and should have a waterproof coat with them.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or half a baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake.

There is a charge of £20.50 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +Pay, our online payment system. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.

Please complete the permission slip below and return to school as soon as possible with confirmation that you have made payment of the £20.50 contribution via +Pay and indicating your child's packed lunch preference.
