Pixies Visit to the Royal Observatory, Greenwich – Wednesday 24 January 2024

As part of our topic work on Space and Travel we are planning to take the children in Pixies Class to the Planetarium, The Royal Observatory, Greenwich on Wednesday 24 January 2024.

The activities will include Ted's Space Adventure and a moon walking workshop.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.30am and will be leaving the Planetarium by 2pm, hoping to be back at school by 3pm. The children should wear smart school uniform and have a waterproof coat with them.
