

	<p>North Pole</p>	<p>The northernmost point on the Earth.</p>		
<p>Prior Knowledge</p>	<p>Southern Hemisphere</p>	<p>The half of Earth that is south of the Equator.</p>

	<p>Tropic of Cancer</p>	<p>The imaginary line around the northern edge of the tropics.</p>
