We are very excited to announce that Year One and Two have been given the opportunity to visit the Southbank Centre, London to experience a live concert as the London Philharmonic Orchestra perform the story of Stan and Mabel based on a book by Jason Chapman and with music by Paul Rissman.

The children will listen to the music as the LPO present this story of these music loving pets. With fun songs to sing with the orchestra, plenty or audience interaction, this is sure to be an unforgettable first experience of a live orchestra. This trip will take place on Thursday 22 February and commence at 12.15pm.

We will be travelling to London by coach, leaving school promptly at 9.30 am, so children arrive at school normal time at 8.40 am for registration in the classroom. We will return to school by the end of the school day at 3.10pm; should the arrival back at school be delayed a text message will be sent to all parents. The children must wear correct school uniform and should have a warm coat with them.

There is a charge of £22.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +Pay, our online payment system. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school. Please do let us know if you do need some financial assistance.

All children will be required to bring a drink and snacks and a packed lunch which they can have at the theatre as this will be a long day for the children. Please may we give a gentle reminder that we are a nut free school and ask that sweets, chocolate, or fizzy drinks are not to be given to the children for their trip.
