Dear Parents,

Natural History Museum Trip Year 3 – Monday 11 March 2024.

We are really pleased to confirm we have been able to book the Natural History Museum and their Dino Dig workshop as part of our Rocks' science topic.

This is a fun hands-on workshop where the children will work in groups to identify a range of fossils, perform their own fossil dig and work out what their mystery specimens might be through observation and measuring. The children will have the opportunity to handle fossils, find out what they are, what they can tell us and how palaeontologists study them to explore prehistoric life on Earth.

We will be travelling to London by coach, leaving school **promptly at 8.20 a.m.** so children must arrive at school no later than 8.10 am for registration in the classroom. Unfortunately, any child who arrives after 8.20 am will not be able to accompany the class on the trip as the coach will have departed. We will return to school by 3.15 pm. Should the arrival back at school be delayed a text message will be sent to all parents.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or half a baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake.

There is a charge of £21.50 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +Pay, our online payment system. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school. Please do let us know if you do need some financial assistance.
