Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 4 Visit to National Maritime Museum– Monday 25 March 2024

We are very pleased to let you know that a trip to the National Maritime Museum has been arranged to support the children's learning as part of our 'Raiders or Settlers' topic. The children will have the opportunity to dig up the past and step into the shoes of a Viking through a hands-on workshop allowing them to discover how the Vikings seafaring talents took them far and wide across the globe. The children will investigate what made the Vikings unique as raiders, invaders and traders, handle replica artefacts and clothing to step into the shoes of a Viking as well as develop enquiry, reasoning and communication skills.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 8.30am and we aim to be back at school between **3:30 and 4pm traffic dependant**. **The children should arrive at school at 8.00am on the day for registration**. The children can wear their own clothes for this visit, which should be suitable for outdoor activities and they should have a waterproof coat to wear on the day.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or half a baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake.

There is a charge of £20.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +Pay, our online payment system. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school. If you are struggling to afford this payment, then please do not hesitate in coming in to speak to us.

Please complete the permission slip below and return to me as soon as possible with confirmation that you have made payment of the £20.00 contribution via +Pay and indicating your child's packed lunch preference.

Parent helpers may be needed for the visit. This will be confirmed at a later date.
