Year 6- Visit to the Imperial War Museum – Wednesday 28 February 2024

We are writing to let you know that we have organised a History trip for Year 6 to the Imperial War Museum on Wednesday 28 February 2024. This links with our current topic on World War II and our previous topic on World War I.

We will be travelling by train from Orpington to London Waterloo East and walking to the museum (a walk of around 1 mile). We will meet outside Orpington Station at 9:20am (on the taxi rank side). Please drop your child off at the station (ensuring there is a member of staff there to receive them). We will return to Orpington Station by 3.00pm, should the arrival back at the station be delayed, a text message will be sent to all parents. You may collect your child from the station at 3.00pm.

If your child is at breakfast club, we will be walking to the station at 8.30 to arrive there in plenty of time for the train. For children returning to After School Club, we will walk back to school at the end of the trip, arriving back at approximately 4.00pm.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake.

The children must wear smart correct school uniform and please do not send any pocket money as we will not be visiting the shop.
