9 Protected Characteristics

We at Farnborough believe it is important that all children gain an understanding of the world they are growing up in, and learn how to live alongside, and show respect for, a diverse range of people. Government guidance also states that this is something that ought to be taught as part of the primary PSHE curriculum.

To ensure we are equipping the children with the skills needed to be well rounded citizens, part of our PSHE lessons this week, we will be covering some or all of 9 Protected Characteristics (depending on the year group). This is to ensure our children understand that:



- Everyone is different
- · Our differences are celebrated
- We are equal in our differences

The Equality Act became law in 2010 to protect everyone in Britain from discrimination, harassment and victimisation due to the protected characteristics we all have. Under the Equality Act, it is against the law to discriminate against anyone because of the 9 protected characteristics, as follows:

- Age
- Disability
- Gender
- Gender reassignment
- Race
- Religion or Belief
- Sexual orientation
- Marriage and civil partnership
- Pregnancy and maternity

This will of course be discussed in a child sensitive and age-appropriate way. The children may have questions which we will answer sensitively.
