## Year 2 Visit to Legoland Windsor- Tuesday 16th July 2024

To consolidate our work in DT, Science and Geography we are planning to take the children in Unicorns Class to Legoland Windsor on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2022. We will be exploring the materials and structures used to construct rides, try out our key mapping skills whilst exploring the resort and identifying the mechanisms and sources of power to operate the different



rides in the resort. These experiences ensure we make connections within our learning whilst having fun!

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 8.00am and we aim to be back at school by 5.00pm. **The children should arrive at school at 7.45am on the day for registration**. The children can wear their own clothes for this visit, which should be suitable for walking around Legoland.



A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or half a baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. Children can also bring their own packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or sweets) and please remember we are a nut free school.

There is a charge of £35.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +PAY, our online payment system. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.
