Cherubs (Year 1) Visit to Broadstairs- Thursday 26 September 2024

We are delighted to let you know that we organised a Geography field trip for Cherubs to Broadstairs on Thursday 26 September 2024.

The field trip links to the children's geography topic titled 'How is Farnborough Village different to Broadstairs?'

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.00am and we aim to be back at school by 3.30pm. The children can wear their own clothes for this visit, which should be suitable for exploring the beach and town. They should have a light waterproof coat to wear on the day.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. Children can also bring their own packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or sweets).

There is a charge of £20.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +Pay only, our online payment system. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.
