Choose your homework from the menu below and record in the homework book: Complete one a week and hand in on Mondays with your reading folders.

For geography learning, we are learning about the United Kingdom and different countries in the UK. Can you look at an atlas with a grown up and find the four countries of the UK and find their capital cities. Can you write the names of these places.



For PE lessons, can you write a set of movements to complete .i.e. 5 star jumps, 7 squats, 8 twists.



For science learning, we are learning about Everyday Materials (metal, plastic, wood, glass, rock, paper and fabric). Can you spot different items around your home made by an Everyday Material? Can you write a list of these objects?



For maths learning, practise writing number facts for numbers 5 to 10. i.e. pairs of numbers that add up to 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10. Number fact to 6.

$$1 + 5 = 6$$

$$2 + 4 = 6$$

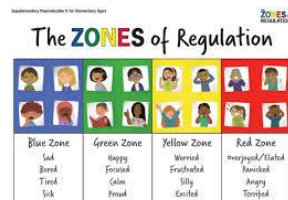
$$3 + 3 = 6$$

Please note number facts to 10 are as important as learning times tables. Children need to be able to recall these quickly and easily once learnt.

For science, we are learning about winter. Go out for a winter walk with a grown up and write about it. Use your senses to describe your walk.



In PSHE, we are learning about what makes us the same and what makes us different from each other. Can you write sentences what makes you the same and different to your family members.



Linked DT, can you find out about windmills. Where do you see windmills? Why do we have windmills? Can you write a few sentences about windmills?



Share, read and talk about a book with an adult. Can you name where the story takes place, it may be more than one place? Can you draw a picture and write the name(s) of the settings.

Can you label and/or write sentences about the setting?
