Dear Parents/Carers,

Unicorns (Year 2) Visit to Gatton Park - Friday 14th March 2025

We are planning to take the children in Unicorns Class to Gatton Park on Friday 14 March 2025. On this visit children will complete a series of measuring activities and a maths trail to rescue woodland animals by solving mathematical problems. This enriching experience will support and reinforce their mathematical learning at school and help to embed key measuring concepts essential in everyday life.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.15am and we aim to be back at school by 3.30pm. The children should arrive at school at 8.35am as normal on the day for registration. The children can wear their PE Kits for this visit, and they should have a waterproof coat to wear on the day.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. Children can also bring their own packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or sweets).

There is a charge of £25.50 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +Pay, our online payment system. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.
