Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 5 Dragons- Visit to Hythe- Wednesday 2 April 2025

Year 5 are delighted to announce that we are off to the coast of Kent for a day trip to Hythe on Wednesday 2 April. We will be leaving school at 8:30am and returning between 3.30 and 4:00pm. On the day, children will need to arrive at school at 8:15am so that we can register them and get them ready for the trip.

This trip will be a culmination of everything that we have learnt during our geography topic this term, 'OS map or Sat Nav - what would you rather use to travel to the coast of Kent?'

Having looked at a variety of digital mapping and Ordnance Survey maps, we will decide on which one we would rather use and why for our coach journey. When we are in Hythe, we will use both types of map to find our way around the town, draw our own maps, find our way to the beach, then finish with playing games. At no point will we be entering the sea.

Comfortable clothes and shoes should be worn as the day will involve walking around the town and beach. The children should bring a rucksack to carry their packed lunch and wallets for the ice cream money.

The cost of the trip will be £17 payable in advance plus £3 per child for an ice cream which they can bring on the day. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions from families, the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.
