Pixies class visit to Hobbledown Adventure Farm Park and Zoo-Tuesday 10th June 2025

As part of our topic work, we are planning to take the children in Pixies Class to Hobbledown Adventure Farm Park and Zoo on Tuesday 10 June 2025.

The activities will include a minibeast workshop, exploring the park with an animal hunt, visiting the Imaginarium, and learning about life on the farm.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.15 am and we aim to be back at school by 2.45 pm. **The children should arrive at school at the normal time of 8:35am on the day for registration.** The children should wear their comfortable school uniform (PE kits), which should be suitable for walking around Hobbledown and they should have a waterproof coat to wear on the day.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. Children can also bring their own packed lunch, no fizzy drinks, sweets or nuts (as we are a nut free school).

There is a charge of £34 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via Iris +Pay, our online payment system in full or by three instalments. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.

Please complete the permission slip below and return to me as soon as possible with confirmation that you have made payment of the £34 contribution via Iris +Pay, if applicable and indicating your child's packed lunch preference.

Parent helpers may be needed for the visit. This will be confirmed at a later date.
