## **Year 1- Cherubs- Visit to Hever Castle – Monday 23rd June 2025**

As part of our monarchy topic, which is featured in our history curriculum, we are planning to take the children in Cherubs Class to Hever Castle in Kent on Monday 23 June 2025. For part of the visit, we will receive a tour of the castle and attend a workshop focussing on what it would have been like to live in a building such as Hever in the late medieval/early Tudor period. Hever Castle was once the childhood home of Anne Boleyn, second wife of Henry V111 and mother of Elizabeth 1.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at approximately 9.15 am and we aim to be back at school by 3.10 pm. **The children should arrive at school at 8.35 am on the day for registration.** The children can wear their PE Kit for this visit, which is suitable for walking around the castle and castle grounds, they should have a waterproof coat to wear on the day.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. Children can also bring their own packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or sweets).

**There is a charge of £30.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via Iris +Pay, our online payment system in full or by three instalments.** Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.
