Year 3 Visit to Sealife London Aquarium- Wednesday 2 July 2025

We are planning to take Pegasus Class to the London Aquarium on Wednesday 2 July 2025 as part of our Geography topic, Blue Planet.

We will be travelling by train from Orpington to Waterloo East, before walking to the London Aquarium. We will meet outside Orpington Station at 9:15am (on the taxi rank side). Please drop your child off at the station (ensuring there is a member of staff there to receive them). We will return to Orpington Station by 3.00 pm, should the arrival back at the station be delayed, a text message will be sent to all parents. You may collect your child from the station at 3.00 pm.

The children should wear their PE kits and they should have a waterproof coat to wear on the day.

All children will be required to bring a drink and snacks and a packed lunch which they can have in Jubilee Gardens after the visit.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake. If you wish to do this, please complete the permission slip below and return to us as soon as possible, indicating your child's packed lunch preference.

After lunch we shall take a walk along the Southbank to Jubilee Gardens and spend some time in the playground weather permitting, before walking back to Waterloo East for the return journey.

There is a charge of £11.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via +Pay, our online payment system. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.

Parent helpers may be needed for the visit. This will be confirmed at a later date.
