Year 3 and 4 - Visit to the National Gallery– Tuesday 3 June 2025

We are writing to let you know that there will be an Art trip for Years 3 and 4 to the National Gallery on Tuesday 3 June 2025.

In the morning, we will be visiting the galleries and looking at a selection of paintings. We have booked a Gallery workshop on the theme of 'Colour' for the afternoon. The children will explore the ways in which artists have used colour and be inspired to create their own experimental responses. Workshops take place in the Gallery itself, using a range of materials and media, provided by the gallery.

We will be travelling by train from Orpington to Charing Cross and walking to the National Gallery. We will meet outside Orpington Station at 9:15am (on the taxi rank side). Please drop your child off at the station (ensuring there is a member of staff there to receive them). We will return to Orpington Station by 3.45pm, should the arrival back at the station be delayed, a text message will be sent to all parents. You may collect your child from the station at 3.45pm.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake.

The children should wear their PE Kit. Please do not send any pocket money as we will not be visiting the shop.
